We Love Reading

We are so passionate about reading in reception class and the children are currently loving all the reading activities we do in school!

After completing reading assessments recently children now all have a reading book matched to their ability. In their book bag each child has an Oxford Reading Tree Book and a Phonics Sound Book. These are to practise at home and will be changed regularly in school.

Each child also has a Browser Story Book which they have chosen themselves, this is a book to read for pleasure and should be kept in the book bag please.

It is really useful for children to recognise the characters from our scheme books so everyone has a laminated sheet with the characters and their names on for the children to learn.

In Reception we learn Tricky Words in our phonics sessions so we've provided a book mark with the tricky words on and it would be great if children could practise these at home.

We will be encouraging the children to bring their book bag into school each day, keep it tidy and to treat their books carefully.

Finally, we really appreciate your support at home with helping your child to learn to read. Even 5 minutes a few times a week would be beneficial in learning this lifelong skill. Feel free to write any comments in the Reading Record book.

After Christmas we are planning to run some reading workshops and there will be more information about this in the New Year.
