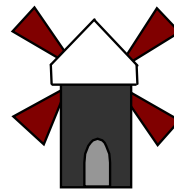

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*For Children with Speech and
Communication Difficulties*



At Holland Moor Primary School we have a Special Educational Resource Facility which is designed to meet the needs of children with speech and communication difficulties.

We work specifically with children in the Foundation Stage and Key Stage One.

We are committed to meeting the individual needs of pupils and ensuring that they make excellent progress.

The aim of the Special Educational Resource Facility is to provide positive learning in a stimulating and friendly environment where each child will feel secure and confident.



All children follow an intensive individualised spoken language programme, which is planned and delivered by a Speech Therapist and Class Teacher.

We offer assessment, advice and therapy for children with a wide range of communication difficulties including: speech/sound difficulties, stammering, language delay/disorder and social communication difficulties.

Our Speech Therapist is based in the Resource Facility, and provides pupils with regular 1:1 sessions where the therapist focuses on the child's specific needs. Group sessions are delivered by both the Speech Therapist and the Teacher.



At our Special Educational Resource Facility, we provide a nurturing and caring environment, which helps to build a child's confidence and self-esteem, in preparation for a future larger class setting.

Alongside the speech and language support every child will experience mainstream integration appropriate to their individual needs. When integrating children receive support to ensure they feel secure and are able to communicate in a larger setting. This helps each child to develop positive relationships with other adults and their peers.

All children take an active role in their own learning from an early age and will be involved in setting their own targets and celebrating their own success.
