Educational provision at Holland Moor including specialist provision



For the vast majority of children attending Holland Moor expected or better than expected progress can be achieved by the quality teaching we offer in every year group and in every classroom. However some children need more direct or specialist teaching in an ongoing way or at specific times in their school life. When we offer a specialist intervention we often produce a support plan and a copy of this plan is always shared with parents or carers. Such a plan contains very specific targets. We try to share the plans at the beginning of a term and we'll be distributing these plans this week. Currently some children are receiving specialist interventions as part of our COVID 19 catch-up programme. We will not be producing support plans for these interventions but we will let parents know they are taking place.

School Swimming Classes

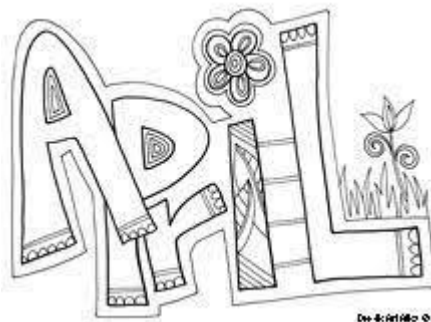


Our swimming lessons will take place on Thursdays. All classes travel and swim separately.
