Can you help with raising extra funds for our school?

We want to take this opportunity to tell you about the 'Match funding' scheme and how a little bit of your time could raise *double* the funds for any fund raising events we do such as the Summer and Christmas Fair.

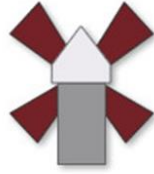
If you work in an organisation that has a match funding policy, any money we raise could be matched by your employer (see the list of companies on the reverse of this letter.) Companies may match fund the total for an event or the total of the stall that their employer is working on. Usually, the employee will need to supply them with a letter from the school detailing the date and nature of the event, together with the total raised.

We understand that the high street banks, building societies, supermarkets and large corporations are likely to do match funding, but these schemes are not exclusive to the major corporate giants. If you work for an independent company, they may be interested in charitable giving through match funding too.

We would be grateful if you could see if your employer has a match funding scheme, or if they are willing to match fund any of our events. If you can't help out this time, but you know the company you work for has a match funding policy, please let us know. This could be a really large source of income for the school and help us raise money for our school.
