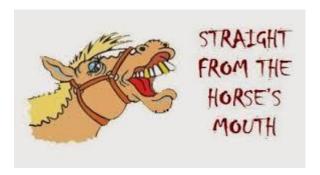
# A Weekend Update from Holland Moor-June 24 2023
